EXPLANATORY NOTES

- Family membership (1) covers all boats owned within the family. Family Racing, Individual Racing and Youth Memberships ((1) (2) and (3) above) entitle the named members to helm in all events and races organised by BSC, (refer also to Sailing Instructions). Fees will be payable to enter the Blakeney and Morston Regatta and any open events as designated by the Committee.
- For Club Membership purposes, Youths are defined as being under 18 years old.
- A Youth Consent Form completed by a Parent/Guardian is a prerequisite for all Youth Members who may take part in Club Events as is compliant with the BSC Youth Policy which is available on the website http://blakeneysailingclub.co.uk/pdf-downloads
- Members who take the non-racing option but wish to participate in club racing, as above, agree to pay £5 per day which should be given to the Race Officer on the day.
