Risk assessment – Petrol Storage

All members should note that BSC is a Community Amateur Sports Club that is run by members for the benefit of members. We all have a responsibility for our own health and safety and the safety of others. It is the member's responsibility to please follow the advice and guidance laid down in this risk assessment and not to engage in any activity that puts you or others at risk of injury.

The following are risks we have identified:

Petrol	Explosion, fire, burns, death. Medium risk	The Bosun, his assistant, Patrol Boat operatives, Club members and visitors	We comply with the Dangerous Substances and Explosive Atmospheres Regulations 2002 (DSEAR) concerned with preventing or limiting the harmful effects of fires, explosions and similar energy-releasing events. We can store up to 275 Litres so long as they are in approved containers and in a locked store for highly flammable liquid.	Petrol containers must be placed on the ground when being filled. Adequate ventilation at all times, No sources of ignition / heat likely to ignite petrol or vapour. sonny.garrett@fire.norfolk.gov.uk of Norfolk Fire Services confirms we do not need a Petrol Enforcing Authority licence but BSC needs to inform them once a year.
