## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

**Races will be sailed under R.Y.A. Rules** (except Rules 6 and 22 as stated below).

**Class.** The following will apply for all classes for which races are given.

**Time of Start.** Race Instructions, including the starting time of the first race and the order in which the classes will start, will be posted on the Club Notice Board when possible during the previous day. The starting gun for the first race will usually be the 10 minute gun for the next class. Courses will be notified on the day of the race.

**10 minutes before Start.** Class Flag will be hoisted at Cooke Posts, or on Committee Boat, indicating position of start, and gun fired.

**5 minutes before Start.** Flag P hoisted and gun fired.

**Start.** Flag P and Class Flag lowered and gun fired.

**Starting Line.** In Cut between Cooke Posts or between mast of Committee Boat and Scaupe Beacon.

**Recalls.** Rule 22 will not apply, but if any boat or boats are over the Line a second gun will be fired, any boat failing to return, if over the Line at the start, will be disqualified.

**Finishing Lines.** Between posts at the top of the Cut near the Quay or between Cooke Posts. May at discretion of starter be altered to further out if tide so dictates.

**Alternative Courses.** White letter on a black ground displayed at the start, will indicate course to be sailed.

**Shortening Course.** Flag S over Class Flag and gun fired at start or on Committee Boat. Finish will then be between mast of Committee Boat and the adjacent Buoy, or the Cooke Posts if no Committee Boat in use.

**Postponement.** Shape hoisted and gun fired at start for every 15 minutes.

**Time Limit.** No limit, but race must be finished before low water. Beacons and Buoys not mentioned in the course instructions in force are not marks of the Course.

**Length of Course.** A and B 7 miles, C and D  $4\frac{3}{4}$  miles, E  $2\frac{3}{4}$  miles.

**Race Officers.** The Committee of the B.S.C.

**Protests** in accordance with Rule 38 to the Starter or Secretary of the B.S.C. within 3 hours of the end of the Race, with 5/- fee.

**CLUB SUBSCRIPTION 10/- per annum payable to Hon. Secretary, who will forward Course Chart as receipt.**

**Shortening Course.** Flag S over Class Flag and gun fired at start or on Committee Boat. Finish will then be between mast of Committee Boat and the adjacent Buoy, or the Cooke Posts if no Committee Boat in use.

**Postponement.** Shape hoisted and gun fired at start for every 15 minutes.

**Time Limit.** No limit, but race must be finished before low water. Beacons and Buoys not mentioned in the course instructions in force are not marks of the Course.

**Length of Course.** A and B 7 miles, C and D  $4\frac{3}{4}$  miles, E  $2\frac{3}{4}$  miles.

**Race Officers.** The Committee of the B.S.C.

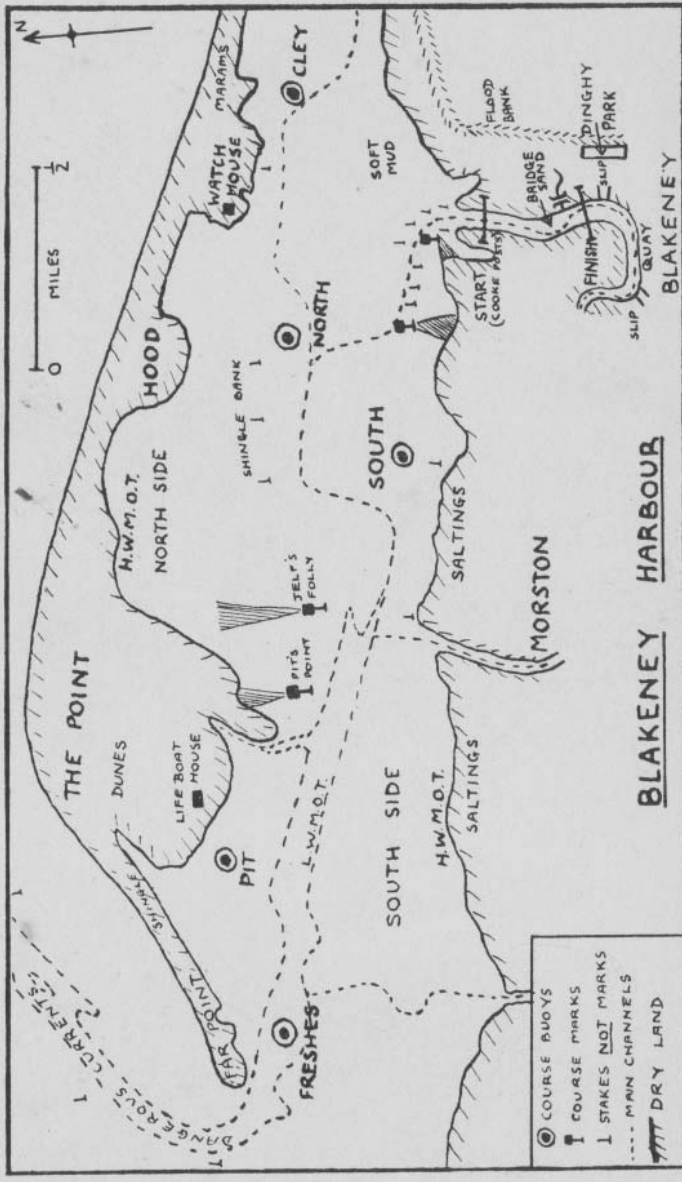
**Protests** in accordance with Rule 38 to the Starter or Secretary of the B.S.C. within 3 hours of the end of the Race, with 5/- fee.
