

Blakeney Sailing Club – Club boat policy

Blakeney Sailing Club owns one sailing dinghy (Laser) for use by members. The following policy outlines how to book the club boat, rules for its use and other general information.

- The dinghy is a Laser 181634 with a full range of sails and spars (Full, Radial and 4.7 rigs).
- The Laser is for use by club members. It is not available for hire by the general public.
- The Laser may be used during scheduled events i.e, races, flotillas, fun week etc. It must not be used at other times.
- If you wish to book it, please email (blakeneysailingclub@gmail.com) indicating when you wish to use it, which rig you wish to use and if you have used it before.
- The club Laser is in the dinghy park and its location is indicated on the club hut.
- If you are not familiar with rigging a Laser then please ask a Club member for help.
- After use the boat must be put away clean and tied down in accordance with dinghy park rules. Any breakages / signs of wear and tear must be reported to the club via email (blakeneysailingclub@gmail.com)
- There are costs associated with the club boat which include insurance, maintenance, repairs, dinghy park fees, storage and transport at the beginning and end of the season. Whilst there is no charge for use of the Laser a voluntary contribution to the Club is therefore welcomed.
- There is no limit on the number of occasions when the Laser can be used, however, if more than one person is seeking to use the Laser then priority will be given to those who have used it the least.
